

Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB) Exam Process

STEP 1

- Complete the NLCSW application process as detailed at <https://nlcsw.ca/registration#how-to-register>. If initial registration requirements are met, an approval to write the appropriate ASWB exam will be issued.

STEP 2

- After receiving approval from NLCSW to write the exam, register and pay the required exam fee with ASWB - www.aswb.org/exam-candidates/exam-registration/

STEP 3

- Once authorization to test is received from ASWB, schedule your exam with a Pearson Vue Professional Centre - www.pearsonvue.com/aswb/

- The exam fee is \$230 US and paid directly to ASWB.
- An exam guide and online practice test are available for purchase from ASWB.
- Each ASWB exam contains 170 multiple-choice questions designed to measure minimum competencies required for social work practice at the candidate's practice level (e.g. BSW or MSW).
- A candidate has 4 hours to complete the exam, which is administered electronically at a Pearson Vue Exam Centre.
- Pearson Vue Exam Centres in Newfoundland and Labrador are located in St. John's and Stephenville.
